With 5 walks to choose from there is something for everyone,
from an easy stroll to an exciting very strenuous walk.

All walks will finish at 3pm we will then get together in Aleluya's for an end of walk drinks and tapas

THE WALKS

Please note that the walks leave a different times and all start at Tourist Information Office, Jalon, GPS co-ords 38.744193,-0.017402.

Walk 1

Start 09.30am. A Very Strenuous (VS) walk led by Mary Gough (Tel: 655676118). 5 hr 30 min, 18 km, 700 m ascent on rough terrain, **only suitable for experienced mountain walkers known to the walk leader**. Jalon circular. A scenic clockwise route above and around Jalon, ascend to Col de Rates, down through Parcent and Alcalali and return from the Western end of Solana – some interesting and demanding 'undulations' but mostly on walked paths.

Walk 2

Start 10.00am. A Strenuous (S) walk led by Ralph Phipps (Tel: 699784253). 5 hr, 14 km, 600 m ascent, includes rough terrain. Col de Rates including summit of Peña Talai.

Walk 3

Start 10.10am. A Moderately Strenuous (MS) walk led by Sue Bonser (Tel: 627269919). 5 hr, 12 km, 550 m ascent, taken at a moderate pace, includes rough terrain. Col de Rates (excl the summit).

Walk 4

Start 12.30pm. An easy/moderate (E/M) walk led by Mike and Jackie Broadley (Tel: 628404020). 3 hr, 9 km, 160 m ascent with some rough terrain, enjoying the delights of the Jalon Valley,

Walk 5

Start 1.30pm. An easy stroll (E), led by Angela Colgate (Tel: 966404192). 2 hr, 5km, 80m ascent, mostly on good tracks and country lanes. From Jalon to Lliber along the riverbed path, visiting Los Arcos medieval water reserve on route. In Lliber you can look around the village, or have a coffee, before we return over the riverbed, through fields and back to Jalon along a quiet country lane.

THE WINE

At 3pm we are all meeting in Aleluya's for a drink and there will be the option of pre-booking **6 tapas and three fine wines for €15**.

This will be Hosted by our resident wine enthusiast Tim Fawle.

Pan allioli, albóndigas, patatas, bravas,
jamón y queso, anchoa pan y tomate, gambas a la plancha con ajos tiernos (2 unidades por persona)
Vinos - un blanco verdejo, un tinto Rioja y un tinto Ribera del duero

All walkers are welcome to join at Aleluyas for just a drink but if you want the 6 tapas and 3 fine wines this must be booked in advance.
