

Spanish Ordnance Survey map download

The National Geographic Institute of Spain now makes available digital mapping which can be downloaded free for non-commercial use.

This means that you can download both 1:50,000 and 1:25,000 sheets for your own use as raster files. (and you could print them if you have either the desire or means to do so!) Each file is at least 7Mb in size. You will need appropriate software to enable you to view and print.

The way to get to these is as follows:-

You may need to find a button at the top right to get this into English.

You will then as a first time user have to register as a user.

Finally you can select the sheets that you want. There are a couple of ways that you can do this. Using the search box and selecting "province" and "alicante" (for example) will produce a full listing of the relevant sheets and you can then chose which one (or more) you wish to download.

Alternatively you can download the full MTN50 grid (button bottom right) which is a very large file but will eventually download and show you a picture of the whole of Spain overlaid with the relevant map sheet numbers.

Once you have done this you will need to complete a few other formalities and then the download commences. You are left with a zip file which contains several different elements, one of which is a .tif file which most image software suites will open.
